







Funding per Enrolled Client by Provider [Q1, 2, 15]






Funding per Exited Client to Mental Health Services by Provider [Q1, Q2, Q26¹]






Percentage Chronically Homeless Served by Provider [Q28i¹]

Arizona (N=31)



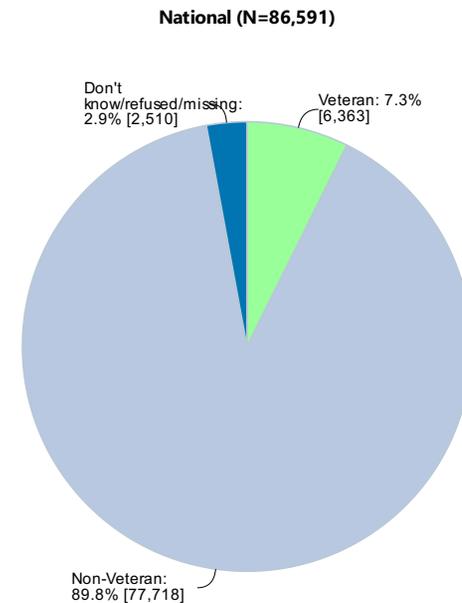







One of PATH's program goals is to link clients to mental health services. 








