


Funding per Exited Client with Substance Use Services by Provider [Q1, Q2, Q27¹]


Percentage Veterans Served by Provider [Q28e]


Percentage Chronically Homeless Served by Provider [Q28i¹]

Percentage with Co-Occurring Disorder Served by Provider [Q28f]













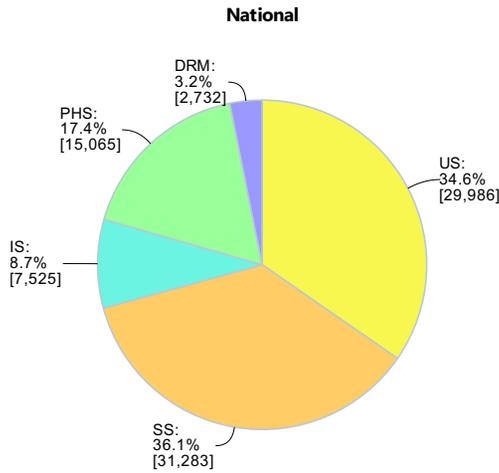

Prior Living Situations by Provider [Q28e, f, i]













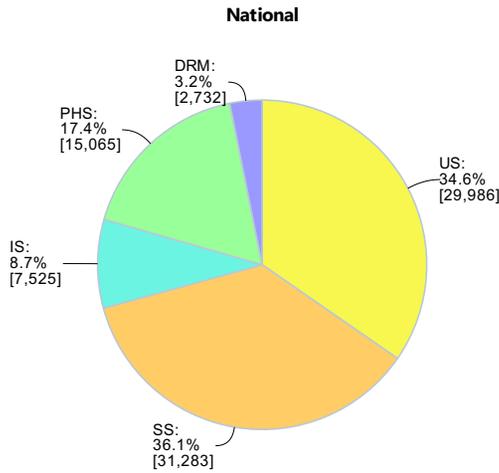

Illinois (N=1,983)



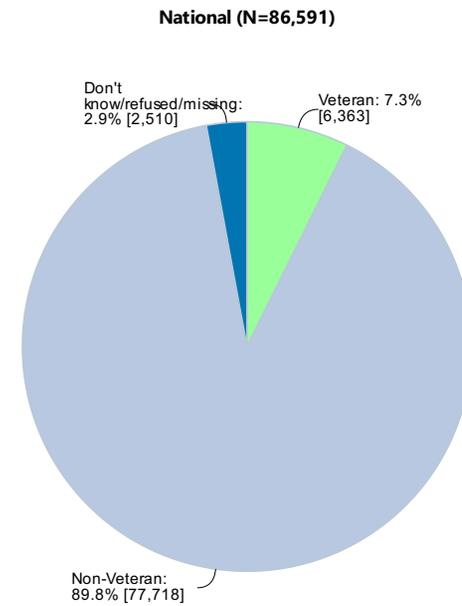









