

Funding per Exited Client to Mental Health Services by Provider [Q1, Q2, Q26<sup>1</sup>]








Percentage Chronically Homeless Served by Provider [Q28i<sup>1</sup>]

Percentage with Co-Occurring Disorder Served by Provider [Q28£]













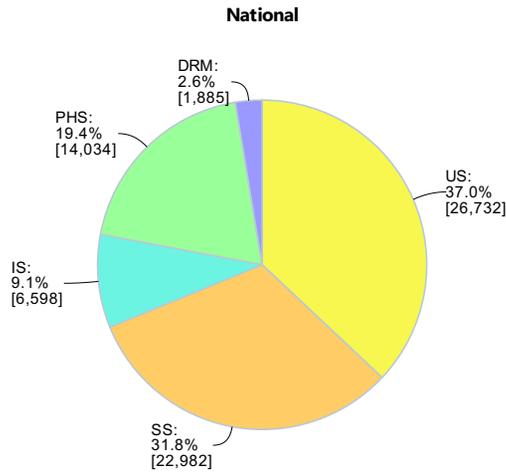




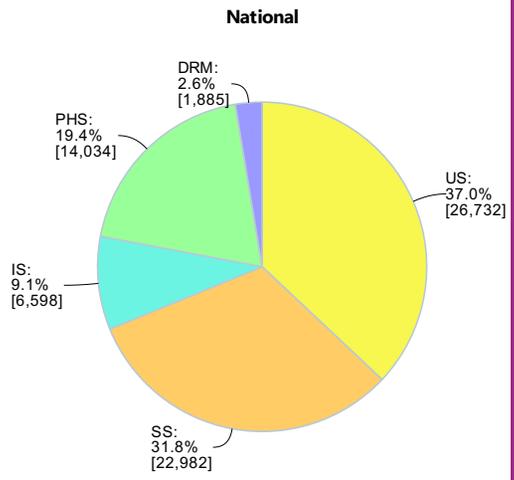
Prior Living Situations by Provider [Q28e, f, i]




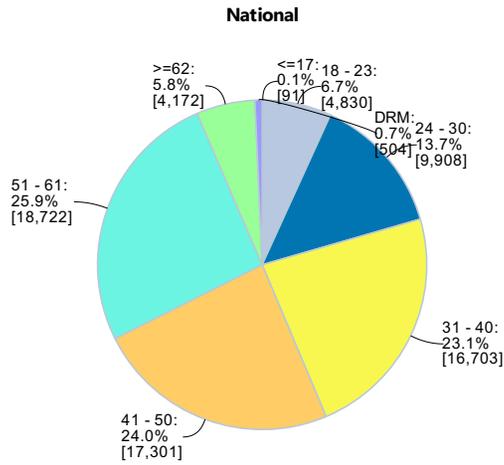
Age by Provider [Q28b]




One of PATH's program goals is to link clients to mental health services. A positive outcome would be to see enrollment rates in mental health services increase from entry to exit, indicating that a greater percentage of clients are enrolled in these services at exit than at the start of their PATH program entry. 









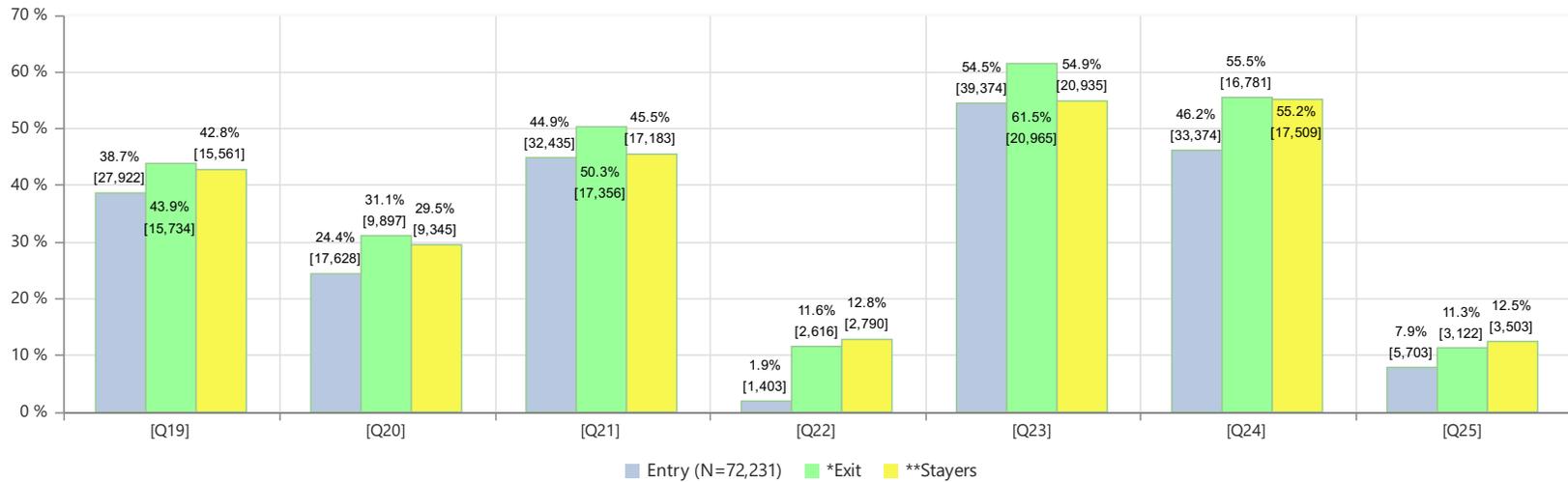
