Funding per Enrolled Client by Provider [Q1, 2, 15]







Funding per Exited Client to Mental Health Services by Provider [Q1, Q2, Q26¹]








Percentage Chronically Homeless Served by Provider [Q28i¹]

Percentage with Co-Occurring Disorder Served by Provider [Q28f]















Prior Living Situations by Provider [Q28e, f, i]


















