
Percentage Chronically Homeless Served by Provider [Q28i]

Percentage with Co-Occurring Disorder Served by Provider [Q28f]













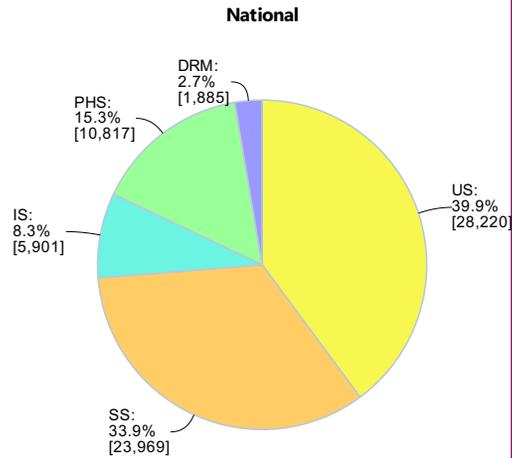







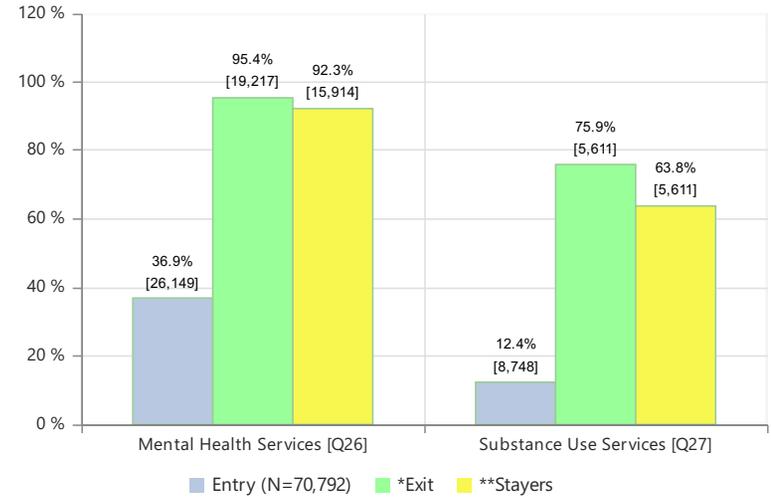



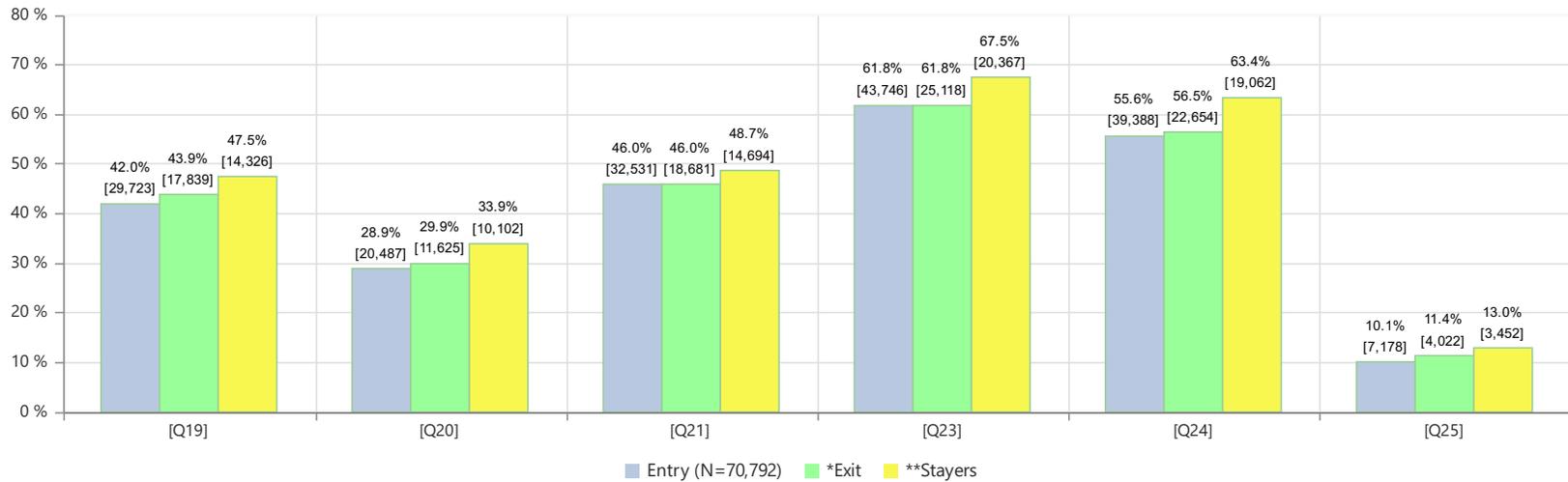
