
Percentage Chronically Homeless Served by Provider [Q28i]

Percentage with Co-Occurring Disorder Served by Provider [Q28f]













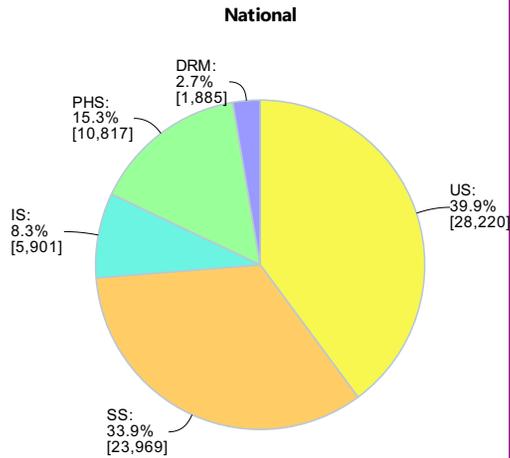

Prior Living Situations by Provider [Q28e, f, i]












Age by Provider [Q28b]







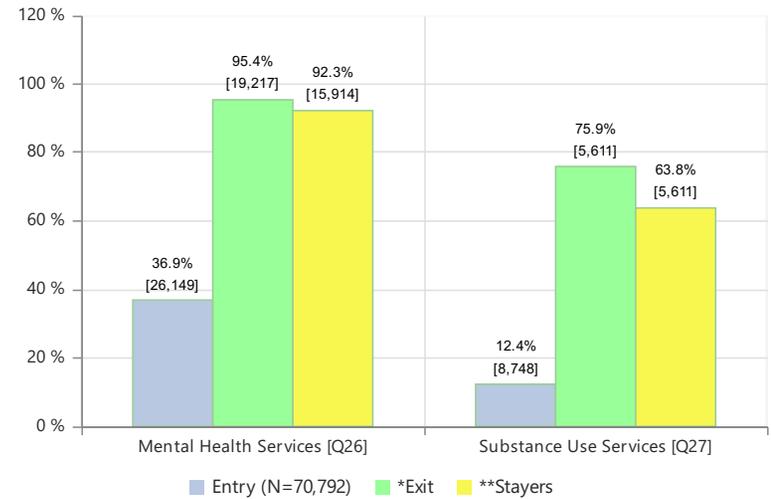

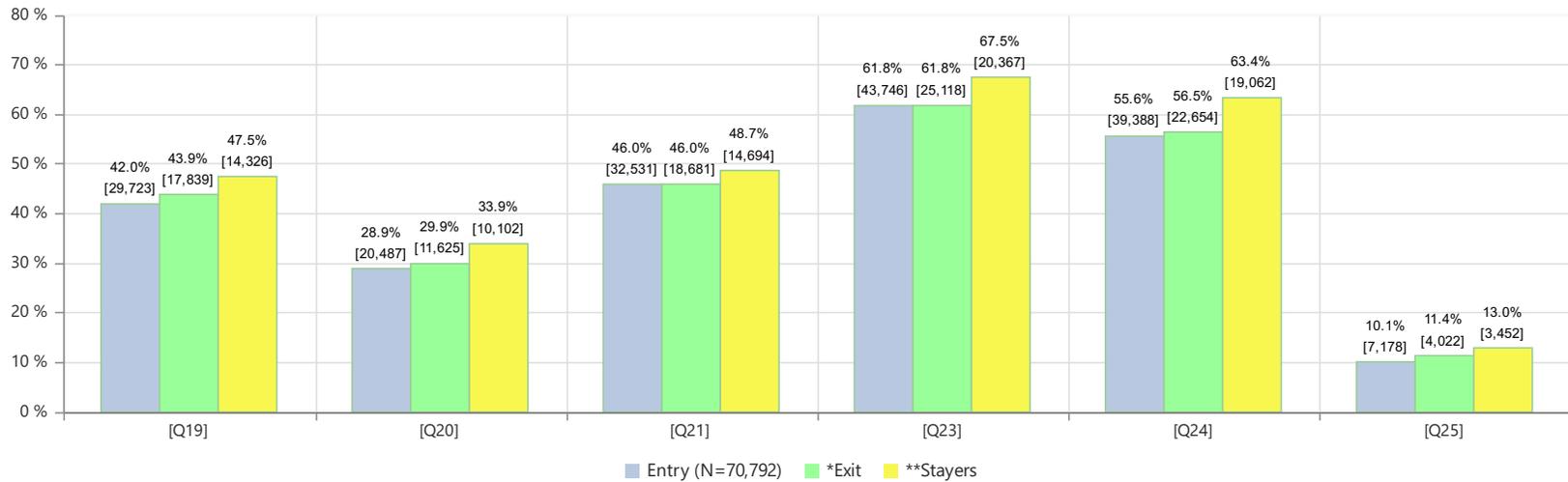
